

## FIRST YEAR CURRICULUM

- **God's Will for Your Life**

This class will guide you to cooperate with the Holy Spirit in order to determine your passion. We are talking about the gift and calling that causes your soul to be stirred to serve the Lord with joy. You will seek to make a plan for your steps that will allow your passion to burn bright.

- **New Testament Survey**

We will look at detailed themes and messages of the twenty-seven books of the New Testament. This class will give you a strong base of understanding onto which your personal study will build a strong working knowledge of this great covenant of promise to all people.

- **Present Day Truth**

This thorough study of Church history reveals that the great reformers, beginning approximately 500 years ago, came forth in their generations declaring truths that had been ignored or neglected. This class will give you true understanding of the word *restoration*.

- **The New Testament Church and Its Ministries**

This class will study of the importance, function and ministries of the local church. This study reveals God's purpose in the earth through the church and its ministries.

- **God's Word and Your Finances**

A thorough search of the Scriptures reveals that God has set clear principles for us to follow in order for us to position ourselves for His provision and prosperity.

- **Servanthood; the Spirit of Christ**

We will study the life of Christ and establish the pattern that He left for us to follow. We will discover the New Testament Church Ministry of Helps by which all ministries are supported by.

## FIRST YEAR CURRICULUM (continued)

- **Children's Ministry**

Our Children's Ministry Pastor and other leaders will be teaching and imparting their love and burden for children. Practical instruction on how to teach children the Bible, build a puppet ministry and how to run a Vacation Bible School are among many of the topics this class will cover.

- **Interpreting the Scriptures**

Since one's doctrine stems from one's interpretation of the Bible and all interpretation is guided by various rules, it seems that the Christian community should focus its attention more on the field of hermeneutics, the science of interpreting the Scriptures.

- **Prayer and Intercession**

We will be reminded of our call to draw near to the Lord and how together we can move the Church into becoming that House of Prayer for all nations.

- **Old Testament Survey**

We will look at detailed themes and messages of the thirty-nine books of the Old Testament. This class will give you a strong base of understanding onto which your personal study will build a strong working knowledge of this covenant of promise to those who believe in Him.

- **Student Ministry**

This class will focus on imparting the heart and passion for effective, purpose-driven Student Ministry. We will have an emphasis on developing structure, volunteer leaders, vision casting and personal ministry techniques. (This class deals with Junior High and Senior High ministry)

- **Evangelism I**

This course will deal with personal evangelism through specific principles. Soul winning will be the main focus of this class. Our call to "go into all the world and preach the Gospel" will be our motivating force.

## SECOND YEAR CURRICULUM

- **God and His Covenants**

We will be studying the covenants that God established with man that led up to the New Covenant of the Lord Jesus Christ. The covenants that God made with Adam, Noah, Abraham and others will give us insight into our covenant of Grace in Christ.

- **The Gifts of the Spirit**

In I Corinthians 12:8, the nine gifts of the Spirit are listed. We will study to see how these gifts are meant to function and how we can stir-up these gifts for effective ministry in our lives today.

- **Prophets and Prophetic Ministry**

Revelations 19:10 states, *the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.* We will study the ministry of the prophet from the Old and New Testaments and how this office functions today. The laying on of hands for activation will be part of this great study.

- **Apostles and Apostolic Ministry**

Ephesians 2:20 states, *His house is built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ being the chief cornerstone.* We will study the clear stream of truth from Old to New Testament to see the vital ministry of the Apostle and how this office functions today.

- **Divine Healing**

Healing for our physical bodies is a specific part of the atonement that Christ paid for on the cross. We need to be convinced of this truth in order to minister His healing to the sick and afflicted among us.

- **Understanding Faith**

The Bible declares five times, *“The just shall live by faith.”* This means that every believer in Christ will live (exist, operate, function, interact, abide, dwell, reside, grow and do business) by faith! This study will uncover the source of our faith and how we are to live by this faith.

## SECOND YEAR CURRICULUM (continued)

- **The Believer and the Holy Spirit**

Jesus spent the latter part of His private time with the disciples preparing them to receive the other Comforter after He was gone. While the Father and the Christ are seated in heavenly places, it is the Holy Spirit who is now with us on this planet, enabling us to fulfill our call to *inherit the earth.*

- **Evangelism II**

Part II of this course will focus on the office of the Evangelist. We will look at the role of the Evangelist to equip and lead the church into evangelism. You will receive specific, practical instruction on how to plan and execute local outreach and evangelism. This study will look at *Apostolic Evangelism* which impacts the world

- **Dynamic Communication**

This course will deal with the practicality of speaking, teaching, and preaching the Word of God. This class will review principles of communication and help the student to prepare a brief message which will be delivered in front of the class. They will then be evaluated and briefed on how to improve their delivery. This is a great class for practical public speaking of all types.

## Intern and Mentoring Term

At the beginning of the second year, all students will pick from the following five practical aspects of ministry: Children’s Ministry, Evangelism, Ministry of Helps, Prayer Ministry and Student Ministry. These will be the five tracts for the second year, term four. This final term, during the summer months, students will not have normal classes on Tuesday evenings. Instead, they will be part of one of these ministry groups to be involved in practical ministry for this ten-week term. Students will be activated in hands-on ministry by experienced ministers who will be mentoring them in their specific areas of expertise.
